## Update on COVID-19 response

In the last 24 hours, the Public Health Laboratory (n=83), Nimule (n=26/4), Bentiu (n=0), Wau (n=0) Bor Hospital (n=0) Malakal (n=0) Torit (n=0), Rumbek (n=0), Nzara(n=0), Yirol(n=0), Tonj (n=0), Abyei (n=0), Ruweng (n=0) and the UN Clinic (n=0), Med Blue(n=254/9) tested 363 samples and released results. Of these, 13 tested positive for COVID-19.
