Update on COVID-19 response

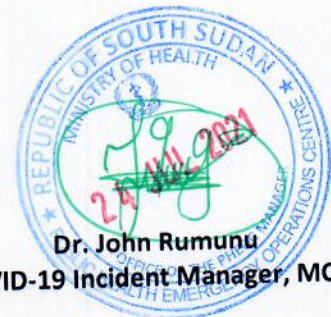
