Update on COVID-19 response

Date: November 16th 2020

In the last 24 hours, the Public Health Laboratory (n=361/4), Nimule (n=36) Bentiu (n=0), Wau (n=0) Bor Hospital (n=0) Malakal (n=0) Torit (n=0), Rumbek (n=0), Kapoeta(n= 0),Yirol(n=0),Tonj (n=0), Abyei (n=0) and the UN Clinic (n=7/4 ,Report of 13th Nov to 16th Nov) tested **412** samples and released results. Of these, **8 tested** positive for COVID19.

Continue to observe the instructions of Health Authorities particularly washing hands regularly with water and soap; maintaining physical distance from other people (at least keep 2 meters (6 feet) distance between two individuals) and mandatory facemask or cloth face coverings in public.
