Update on COVID-19 response

Date: 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2020

As of 8<sup>th</sup> of June 2020, the Ministry of Health Public Health Emergency Operation Center has documented cumulative cases of 1,549. Out of these, 1,195 are male and 354 are female.
