Update on COVID-19 response

Date: 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2020

In the last 24 hours, 137 samples were tested and results released. Of these, three tested positive for COVID19. The new cases identified are all adult male from South Sudan. However, 1,305 samples are still pending.
